

NORTH CAROLINA

BAKERSVILLE (MITCHELL COUNTY)

GREEN FELDSPAR, THULITE, MOONSTONE: AT Hawk mine

UNAKITE: N 10 miles at Roan Mountain

SUNSTONE: A mile N at Meadlock Mountain

CYANITE: SE 4 miles on Hwy 226 in Quartz near top of Yellow Mtn.

BLUFF (MADISON COUNTY)

UNAKITE: On Roaring Fork Creek - $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of its junction with Meadow Fork, 2 miles SW of Bluff, also $\frac{1}{3}$ mile north of Bluff.

BRASSTOWN (GRAY COUNTY)

STAUROLITE: This well-known deposit of Staurolite (Fairy stones) is now easily accessible to collectors. Good and perfect crystals are found in the bank of the gravel road and in the adjoining pasture land. Matrix specimens occur in great quantity over the mountainside woodland. These crystals are mostly single or oblique angle twins but occasionally good right angle twins are found. Staurolite also occurs at other places along the same belt in this area but is not so easily accessible, and being in the woodland, is not so
