road leads one mile to the mine.

THULITE: Go 8 miles E on U.S. 19E to county line bridge over Crabtree Creek. Turn S on Crabtree Road 3 miles to sharp left turn; Turn right here onto dirt road  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to Number 20 Mine for Thulite.

BERYL, THULITE, AMAZONITE; Return to Crabtree Road and continue 3 miles E & S to bridge where pavement ends; turn left on dirt road 100 yds. to McKinney mine for amazonite, massive beryl, and red Thulite.

EMERALD: Continue on road to fork 2 miles, at church keep left a mile to end of road, and hike 2 miles to Crabtree Emerald Mine to collect in dumps. (Fee charged.)

## CASHIERS (JACKSON COUNTY)

SAPPHIRE: SE 7 miles at Whitewater river to Whitewater mine.

RUBY: E 7 miles near Sapphire lake at Bad Creek Mine.

## CASAR (CLEVELAND COUNTY)

RUTILATED QUARTZ: In soil 2 Miles W
